

Christian Arts & Theater's Dress Code

CAT expects students to dress appropriately for the class they are taking. Overly tight or revealing clothing is not acceptable. Midriffs must be covered, even when arms are raised or when a student is seated. For safety reasons closed-toed shoes must be worn at all times.

Class Dress Codes

Jazz / Ballet Combo:

Ballet shoes and/or jazz shoes, leotard & tights (any color and may wear skirts if they wish), hair out of face

Act / Sing Combo:

Closed-toe shoes and comfortable clothes

Dance / Sing Combo:

Closed-toe shoes and comfortable clothes

Contemporary:

Jazz shoes or half-soles and well-fitted dancewear

Hip Hop:

Sneakers and comfortable clothes

Jazz:

Jazz shoes and well-fitted dancewear

Leaps & Turns:

Jazz shoes or half-soles and well-fitted dancewear

Lyrical:

Jazz shoes or half-soles and well-fitted dancewear

Broadway Jazz:

Jazz shoes and well-fitted dancewear

Tap:

Tap shoes and comfortable clothes

Musical Theater:

Jazz shoes or Athletic sneakers and comfortable clothes (no skirts)

Acting (including Improv):

Closed-toe shoes and comfortable clothes

Voice:

Closed-toe shoes and comfortable clothes

Specialty Classes:

Check with our staff for the appropriate attire
